When you win, you get a summary of your game:

The Keys: As you play Phrygian cards, a unique sequence of keys is made from left to right.

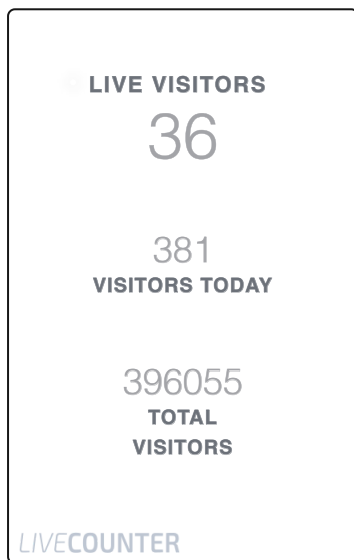
The Melody: The sequence of Phrygian notes.

The Harmony (Squared): The first non-Phrygian card played (face down) in each key.

Each game is played with a shuffled deck of 84 cards, so every time you win, the game 'writes' you a unique song using Integration Theory!
